

Spanish Enrichment Program

Enrollment for the Spanish class is now open. You may enroll for one or all sessions.

Classes will be held from 8:00 to 8:50 a.m. All materials are included in the registration fee. Students must be available for both days to enroll. Some scholarships are available. If you would like more information about scholarships, please contact Opstad's counselor, Steve Bates at 831-8319.

Every class will include the following: Presentations, weather, day of the week, new material presented w/ props and charts, work sheets (optional,) practice reading/writing, game or group activity. Children will learn about the culture, music, food, vocabulary, holidays and some of the unique animals found in the countries covered. Class size is a minimum of 6 students and all levels are welcome. Students will learn new vocabulary in each term's course, with review and repetition throughout the year.

Spanish I – Tuesday/Thursday - This introductory Spanish conversation course is for students from 2nd to 5th grade and will be conducted in both Spanish and English, with a high emphasis on comprehension, conversation and helping students feel comfortable and confident with the Spanish language.

-1- Spanish I/Fall

Session runs from October 6 – December 15 (9 1/2-week session)

Dates: **Oct** - 6, 8, 13, 15, 20, 22, 27, 29 / **Nov** - 3, 5, 10, 12, 17, 19 / **Dec** – 1, 3, 8, 10, 15
\$133 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by September 24, 2009

We will be covering: Meeting & Greetings, Numbers 1-100, Colors and Important Phrases (Important Phrases will cover some very basic phrases like "Do you speak English", "I don't understand", "How do you say... in Spanish". We will study Puerto Rico.

-2- Spanish I/Winter

Session runs from January 12 – March 25, 10 -week session.

Dates: **Jan** - 12, 14, 19, 21, 26, 28 / **Feb** - 2, 4, 9, 11, 23, 25 / **March** - 2, 4, 9, 11, 16, 18, 23, 25
\$140 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by January 6, 2010

We will be covering: Big Little Words like "I, we, they, and, but, because," The Calendar, the Classroom, and Verbs: To Have, To Be and To Be Called. We will also be reviewing Colors, Greetings and Numbers from 1-100. We will study Spain.

-3- Spanish I/Spring

Session runs from April 13 – June 4, 8-week session.

Dates: **April** - 13, 15, 20, 22, 27, 29 / **May** - 4, 6, 11, 13, 18, 20, 26, 28 / **June** - 1, 4
\$112 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by April 2, 2010

We will be covering: Body Parts, Food, the Restaurant, Important phrases like "Where is it? How much? Can you help me?" We will also be reviewing Colors, Greetings and Numbers from 1-100. We will study Ecuador.

Spanish II – Monday/Wed - This advanced Spanish class requires completion of Spanish I or teacher approval. Course is for students from 2nd to 5th grade and will be conducted mostly in Spanish; English will be used to explain concepts, with a high emphasis on comprehension, conversation and introduction to grammar.

-4- Spanish II/Fall

Session runs from October 5 – December 14 (9 -week session)

Dates: **Oct** - 5, 7, 12, 14, 19, 21, 26, 28 / **Nov** - 2, 4, 9, 16, 18, 30 / **Dec** - 2, 7, 9, 14

\$126 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by September 24, 2009

Review, numbers and colors, advanced greetings (How is it going? Nice to meet you, same here), intro to pronouns (I, you, he, she), verbs, “to be”, “like”, ser and estar, gustar, definite articles, indefinite articles, nationalities, the city, in the classroom. We will study Puerto Rico.

-5- Spanish II/Winter

Session runs from January 11 – March 29, 10-week session.

Dates: **Jan** - 11, 13, 20, 25, 27 / **Feb** - 1, 3, 8, 10, 22, 24 / **March** - 1, 3, 8, 10, 15, 17, 22, 24, 29

\$140 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by January 6, 2010

Handy questions (How much? How many? What? When? Where is...? Can I? Can we? How? Who? Why?), clothes, in the bathroom, the kitchen, characteristics, common “ar”(to listen, to speak, to look, to need, to finish, to teach, to ask, to touch, to work, to use, to travel, to visit. We will also be reviewing Colors, Greetings and Numbers. We will study Spain.

-6- Spanish II/Spring

Session runs from April 12 – June 2, 7 1/2-week session.

Dates: **April** - 12, 14, 19, 21, 26, 28 / **May** - 3, 5, 10, 12, 17, 19, 24, 26 / **June** - 2

\$105 payable to OPSTAD PTA (\$7 per class) by April 2, 2010

Time, the home, the family, the seasons, at the table, Common “er”verbs (to learn, to drink, to eat, to understand, to run, to believe, to read, to sell). We will also be reviewing Colors, Greetings and Numbers. We will study Ecuador.

To enroll your child, please complete this registration form. Please return the form with payment (checks payable to OPSTAD PTA) for the total tuition amount. Forms and payment may be brought to the office (please DATE your envelope and write “Spanish Program” on the outside).

You do not need to commit to all 3 quarters at this time, but future entrance into a class is based on space available. There is a maximum number of students and your child may not be able to participate if we reach capacity. We appreciate your payment for the entire year now, but the official due date for the **FALL term is September 24th** and all envelopes must clearly state the **date** of your registration submission. The due date for the **WINTER term is January 6th** and the **SPRING term due date is April 2nd**.
